

Transportation/Parking

Airports

John Wayne (Orange County) Airport is 13 miles away from the Orange County Hyatt Regency. Super Shuttle is available each way for \$11 per person.

Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) is 35 miles away from the Orange County Hyatt Regency. Super Shuttle is available each way for \$17 per person.

Long Beach Airport is 18 miles away from the Orange County Hyatt Regency. Super Shuttle is available both ways. Rate for the 1st person is \$35 and \$9 for each additional person each way.

Rental cars, limousines, and taxis are available as well.

Disneyland Shuttle offers shuttle service between Disneyland and the Orange County Hyatt Regency every half hour. Rates are \$5 per adult & \$2 for Children (ages 4-10), per day. Children 3 and under ride FREE.

Hotel parking is available on-site at the Orange County Hyatt Regency. A special \$14 per day rate has been negotiated for self-parking. Valet parking is also available.


